



City of Ramsey Public Works

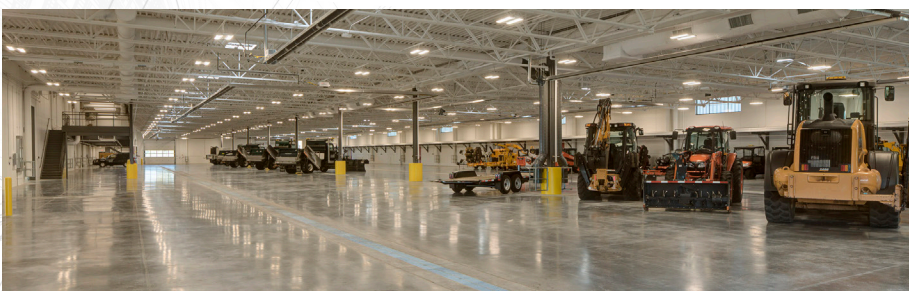
RJM worked with the City of Ramsey to build a new 93,000-square-foot public works facility, completed on budget and ahead of schedule.
